The N.K. Ishmukhamedov Grant is not a state-funded educational grant. It is a form of non-governmental targeted educational support financed by the Sponsor and includes a monthly scholarship of KZT 150,000.



GRANT OBJECTIVES

1. To support talented and promising students.
2. To expand access to higher education.
3. To encourage academic excellence, discipline, and social responsibility.
4. To develop a community of future leaders committed to professional growth, research activities, and social responsibility.
5. To preserve the legacy of N.K. Ishmukhamedov (Rector of the Factory Technical Higher Educational Institution at the Karaganda Metallurgical Combine from 1970 to 1988, Professor, Honored Worker of Science and Technology of the Republic of Kazakhstan, and Honorary Metallurgist) through this educational initiative.



ELIGIBILITY

The Program is open to citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan who permanently reside, are officially registered, or have graduated from an educational institution located in the city of Temirtau or nearby settlements of the Karaganda Region.

Applicants must be prospective students enrolling in a full-time undergraduate program and must simultaneously meet the following requirements:

- Unified National Testing (UNT) score of at least 75 points;
- Admission to a priority educational program.



APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT

1. Completed application form.
2. Copy of a valid identity document.
3. Documents confirming enrollment or admission.
4. Academic transcript or another official academic record; UNT certificate for prospective students.
5. Motivation essay.
6. Documents confirming the applicant's connection with the city of Temirtau, nearby settlements, and/or the Karaganda Region.
7. Any other supporting documents relevant to participation in the Program.



SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Academic performance.
2. Quality of the motivation essay.
3. Participation in research, community service, volunteer work, sports, or other socially significant activities (supported by diplomas, certificates, awards, or letters of appreciation).
4. Relevance to the University's priority fields of study.
5. The applicant's connection with the city of Temirtau, nearby settlements, and/or the Karaganda Region, confirmed by official registration, permanent residence, graduation from a secondary, technical, or vocational educational institution in the region, or other supporting documents.
6. Social status, including: orphans and children deprived of parental care; students from large families; children of combat participants or veterans of the Afghan War; students from single-parent families.
